

OUR MISSION & VISION

ACHIEVEability is dedicated to permanently breaking the generational cycle of poverty for low income and homeless families in West Philadelphia.



WHO WE SERVE



ACHIEVEability's service area covers the Headington and Cobbs Creek neighborhoods in West Philadelphia. Poverty in our predominantly Black (88.6%) community is a manifestation of systematic oppression and racial injustice. As a result of decades of chronic disinvestment, our neighborhood has a poverty rate of **34.5%** and an unemployment rate of **12.1%**.

40.8% of Haddington and Cobbs Creek families with children under 18 are living below the poverty level, a statistic which is **43**% higher than the Philadelphia average (28.5%).

OUR AREAS OF FOCUS

By focusing on these categories, ACHIEVEability is actively working towards a safe, equitable, and vibrant West Philadelphia.



Economic Mobility: Coaching and down payment support for first-time homebuyers, training and placement in living wage jobs, and support to complete college degrees.



Small Businesses: Technical assistance, connection to capital, and storefront improvement.



Basic Needs: Connection to public benefits, rental and energy assistance, foreclosure prevention, tax preparation, affordable housing, vaccination, computer lab access, and distribution of items (e.g. clothes, shoes, diapers, and backpacks).



Quality of Life: Gun violence prevent programming for young adults ages 16-24, safety improvements, public space improvements, and community cohesion events.

60th Street Strong

The 60th Street Strong Coalition is ACHIEVEability's response to the rising gun violence crisis in our neighborhood. The mission of this project is to provide youth that are commonly drawn to violent or criminal activities with alternative, positive opportunities to receive gainful employment, skills, and mentorship from local, Black-owned businesses that we partner with.

The ultimate goal of 60th Street Strong is to lower rates of violence in the area, improve perceptions of safety, foster community cohesion, and stimulate the local economy.

IMPACT SNAPSHOT

406 young adult participants (100% Black, 64% male, 36% female)

83% experienced no new instances of gun violence

85% completed the program

89% reported site placement was helpful to reach professional goals

100% reported positive experiences with their job placement & professional development sessions
