Founded in 2010, Kensington Soccer Club (KSC) runs accessible soccer programs in order to provide our community with healthy activities, positive environments, enrichment programs, and employment opportunities. The goal was simple: provide greater access to soccer for youth in the Broader Kensington area.

GET INVOLVED

KSC faces several significant barriers in providing youth sports programs, including funding and resource constraints due to our pay-what-you-can model, which limits access to consistent financial support for equipment, coaching, and facility maintenance. Challenges include finding and maintaining suitable spaces for year-round activities, exacerbated by high costs and limited public funding for community-based sports spaces. Systemic inequities in youth sports funding disproportionately affect low-income areas like Kensington, restricting opportunities for our youth. Additionally, safety concerns in a community affected by poverty and gun violence further hinder consistent participation in KSC's programs.


