OUR PROGRAMMING: RECREATION OVER VIOLENCE

Recreation Over Violence (ROV) was created to support children and families through anti-violence initiatives. Our innovative program uses recreation as a powerful tool to prevent and address violence and substance abuse among at-risk youth. Inspired by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime's findings in April 2021, we leverage sports as a community engagement strategy to combat crime, violence, and potential drug use. Through the ROV program, we go beyond recreation by integrating essential life skills training, including building self-esteem, resisting peer pressure, and mastering effective communication. This holistic approach ensures we align with global best practices to empower youth and create safer communities.

Services Provided:



Case Management: ROV Specialists maintain regular contact with families of participating children and youth to ensure consistent attendance and remove barriers to participation.



Outreach: ROV Specialists maintain a database of prior participants for outreach and ongoing engagement.



Family Support: Specialists refer families to external services and supports as needed.



Barrier Removal: Proactively addressing challenges that might hinder youth and families from fully participating in programs.
