To promote awareness regarding dynamics associated with domestic and intimate partner violence. To prevent harm and promote healing for youth and adults, both in and outside of the criminal justice system, we provide trauma and grief counseling, coupled with spiritual and emotional support.

WHO WE SERVE

Clients are typically offenders and/or victim/survivors of domestic/intimate partner violence, human trafficking, and other violent crimes, and their offspring. We engage students in the public school, charter and private school systems who are having difficulty processing their anger. We also serve Veterans, juveniles, at risk-youth who are in placement, returning citizens, persons who have been court mandated to take anger management and/or domestic violence training, as well as those in need of grief support.



OUR APPROACH

Through trauma-informed counseling, support groups, and the arts, we empower survivors to heal, build resilience, and foster healthy relationships. Community outreach and advocacy further address systemic issues related to domestic and intimate partner violence.

Our trainings and services are conducted in men's and women's prisons, schools, churches, and Northwest Victims of Crime and North Central Crime Victim's facilities.

OUR PROGRAMS & SERVICES

- **Trauma Counseling:** Individual and group sessions to help process and recover from traumatic experiences.
- Overdose Prevention: Supports recovery, relapse prevention, and emotional resilience for those struggling with substance use.
- Anger Management: Helps participants identify triggers and develop healthy coping mechanisms.
- **Grief Support:** A safe space to process loss and heal.
- **Mental Health Support Groups:** Peer-led groups promoting emotional wellness and community support.
- One-on-One Counseling: Personalized sessions addressing PTSD, depression, and other mental health challenges.

Domestic Violence Prevention & Intervention: Offers educational resources, safety planning, and counseling to escape abusive situations.

OUR OUTREACH

Unfortunately, there are countless homicide related deaths due to domestic violence. NewView promotes domestic violence awareness through events like the *Remember My Name Prayer Vigil*, citywide tabling, nature therapy walks, support circles, empowerment sessions, and an annual retreat, while also recognizing female leaders at the *Brooch of Elegance Gala*.
