Anti-Violence Initiative: a proactive community program dedicated to addressing and reducing violence in our neighborhoods. Through a multifaceted approach, we aim to tackle the root causes of violence while providing support and resources to individuals and communities affected by it.



Anti-Drug Initiative: a comprehensive community initiative aimed at combating drug abuse and addiction in our neighborhoods. Through education, prevention, and support, we strive to reduce the harmful impact of drugs on individuals, families, and communities.

Crisis Intervention: grants us access to information beyond the reach of law enforcement, enabling us to implement preventive measures in most cases before situations escalate.



Saturday Workshops: provides participants with positive alternatives, offering opportunities to explore new approaches and break away from familiar routines.



Sporting Competitions: supportive, non-judgmental space where youth can connect and build relationships, all while receiving valuable mentorship.
